Per your request for a Desktop survey to identify previously recorded historic and prehistoric properties within a one mile radius of the proposed 18.5-acres for the Natchitoches Site project in Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana, TerraXplorations, Inc. (TerraX) provides the following information:

## PROJECT LOCATION





Figure 2. Topographic map showing project area.

The proposed tract encompasses 18.5 acres (7.48 hectares). The property is located approximately 1,200 meters south of the Cane River, west of Rapides Drive and north of LA-1 in Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana (Figure 1). It can be found in Sections 72, 73, 74, Township 9 North, Range 7 West on the 1983 (photorevised 1992) Natchitoches South, Louisiana USGS 7.5' series topographic quadrangle (Figure 2).

## LITERATURE AND DOCUMENT SEARCH

A literature and document search was conducted in order to gather pertinent background information regarding the subject property and its surroundings. This research included inspections of the Louisiana Site Files (Louisiana Division of Archaeology [LDOA] 2019) and the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) (National Park Service 2019).

A search of the LSF (LDOA 2019) found seven (7) archaeological sites within a one-mile radius of the project area. There have been fourteen (14) archaeological surveys conducted within a one-mile radius of the project area (Figure 3). No previously recorded historic structures are located within one mile of the project area. More information about these resources can be found in Tables 1 and 2.




Figure 4. Project area shown on the 1921 Natchitoches Parish soil map.

Historic maps, including the 1921 Natchitoches Parish soil map, 1937 Bermuda, Louisiana 1:31680, 1943 Provencal, Louisiana 15', 1945 Provencal, Louisiana 15', 1957 Provencal, Louisiana 15', and 1983 Natchitoches South, Louisiana 7.5' were also inspected for the presence of any structures in the project area (Figures 4-9). No historic structures were shown on the 1957 and 1983 but the other four maps. These structures are no longer standing but will probably be represented as archaeological sites if the project area is surveyed.




Figure 5. Project area shown on the 1937 Bermuda, Louisiana 1:31680 USGS Topographic Quadrangle.




Figure 6. Project area shown on the 1943 Provencal, Louisiana 15' USGS Topographic Quadrangle.






Figure 7. Project area shown on the 1945 Provencal, Louisiana 15'USGS Topographic Quadrangle.




Figure 8. Project area shown on the 1957 Provencal, Louisiana 15' USGS Topographic Quadrangle.






Figure 9. Project area shown on the 1983 Natchitoches South, Louisiana 7.5' USGS Topographic Quadrangle.
