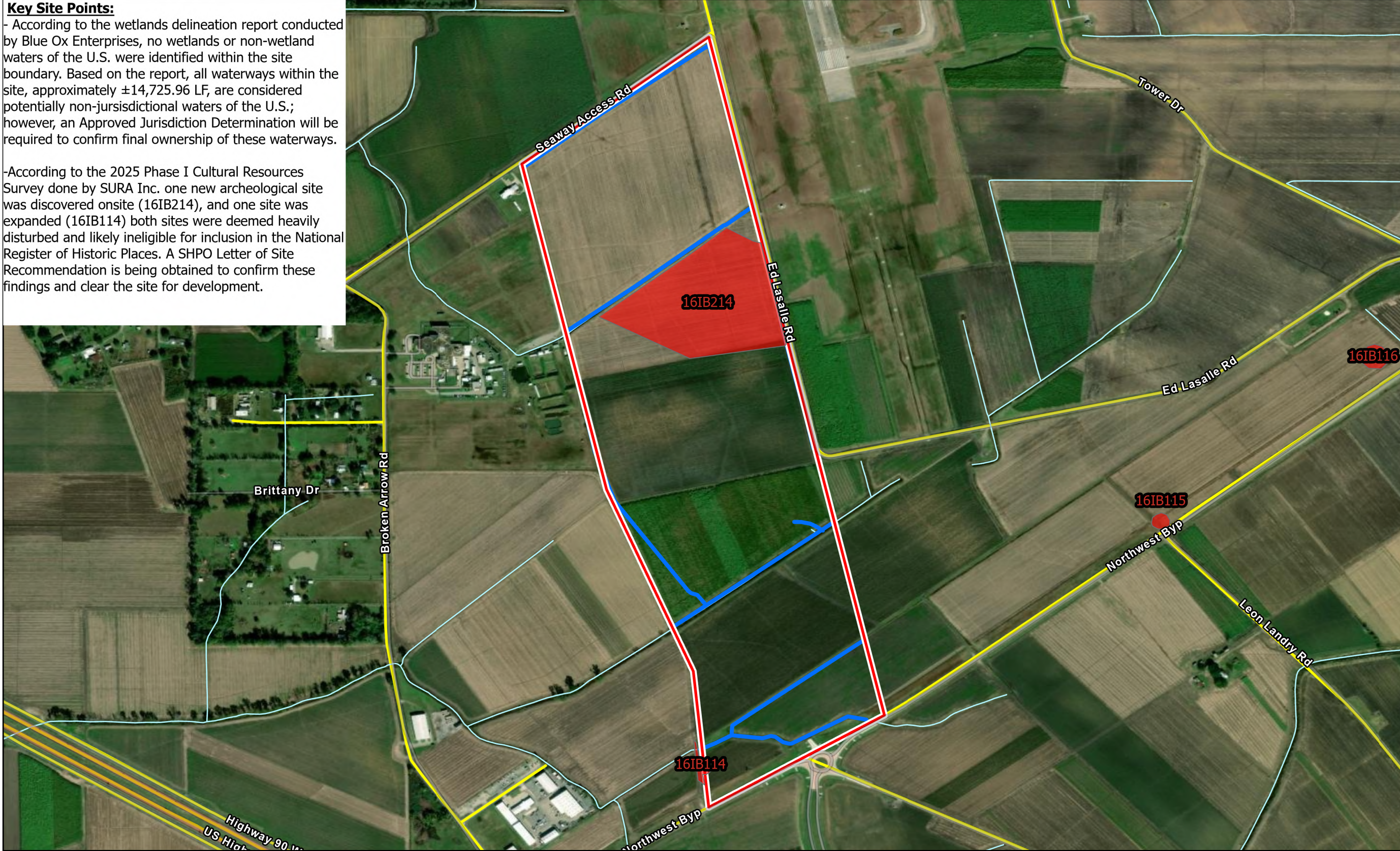
Acadiana Regional Airport P5 Site Wetlands & Cultural Encumbrances Map

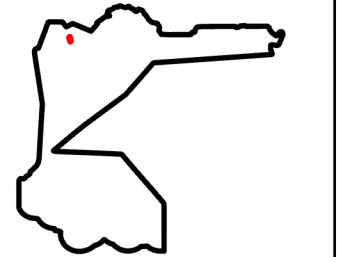
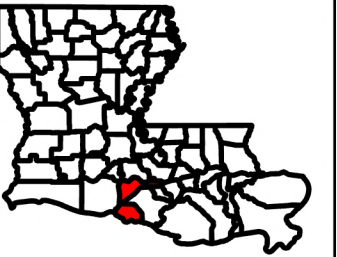
Key Site Points:

- According to the wetlands delineation report conducted by Blue Ox Enterprises, no wetlands or non-wetland waters of the U.S. were identified within the site boundary. Based on the report, all waterways within the site, approximately ±14,725.96 LF, are considered potentially non-jurisdictional waters of the U.S.; however, an Approved Jurisdiction Determination will be required to confirm final ownership of these waterways.

-According to the 2025 Phase I Cultural Resources Survey done by SURA Inc. one new archeological site was discovered onsite (16IB214), and one site was expanded (16IB114) both sites were deemed heavily disturbed and likely ineligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. A SHPO Letter of Site Recommendation is being obtained to confirm these findings and clear the site for development.
