We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 13 March 2015 and two copies of the above referenced report. We have completed our review of this report and have no comments to offer.

We concur that site 16AN107 is undetermined with respect to its eligibility for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places, and that sites 16AN108 and 16AN109 are not eligible for nomination to the National Register. Our office recommends that additional investigations be conducted at 16AN107 to determine the site's eligibility if the site cannot be avoided during development of the property.
