This is in response to your request for a letter from AT&T Louisiana for the Summit Technology and Business Park in Slidell, Louisiana for a cite certification. Based upon our preliminary findings, AT&T stands ready to provide you with voice and data telecommunications (including Internet Service) to sufficiently serve the proposed site. Upon receipt of the specific telecommunications needs of your future clients, we will be in a better position to determine what, if any, additional network facilities may be required subject to our engineering and design requirements.

AT&T currently has facilities near the proposed site. It is important to note that as this project develops, we may need additional right of way for a Remote Terminal (RT) site depending on the density of this industrial park. If required we would need 180 days to bring new facilities into this area. Over time, AT&T has deployed several different types of network infrastructure in this area; therefore this development will be served with the most current AT&T approved technology which includes fiber optics, coaxial and copper facilities.
